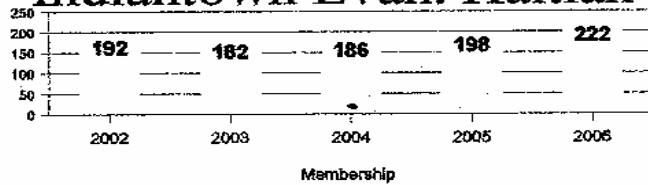
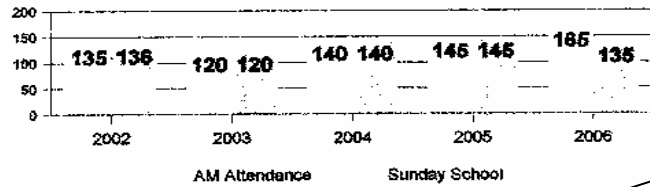
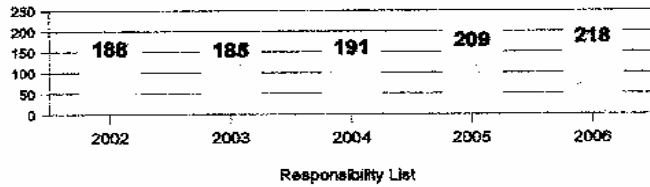

Pastor's Written Report

Using the space provided, each pastor is asked to give a written report of significant accomplishments made in the 2006-2007 church year. You do not need to report statistics because they will appear in the top half of your church's page.

In this space we would like to read a summary of one of your **"Resurrection Stories"** – a testimony of a life that was changed through the ministry of your church this past year.

Or, what new ministries have you started this past year or do you intend to start in the coming year?

Remember the **Centennial Faith Projections** you completed at last year's Assembly to be completed by the 2008-2009 year? A report on these would be great or **your plan of action to complete them**. For example, our sample church is Indiantown Evangelical. Pastor Pascal Permis projected 300 Members, a morning worship attendance of 250, Sunday School attendance of 200, 4 new ministry initiatives, two daughter congregations started, and 150 New Nazarenes by October 2009. His report would include Indiantown's plan for achieving these goals.

If your church needs special prayer, you might also include a **prayer request** that our Southern Florida Prayer Partners can agree in prayer about throughout the year.

If your church is facing a major **building project** or some other special occurrence, please report that and how we can assist you in prayer. We do not need to know about how you fixed the church toilets or painted the restrooms, but major renovations could be noted.

If you received **Nazarene Disaster Relief** to fix your parsonages or church buildings, you might want to note that in your report. As you do your report, use one-inch margins as I have done in giving you this sample. Thank you for your cooperation,
